



Sunnyvale Alliance Soccer Club (SASC) Coach Education & License Program

Overview

This program is designed to promote and support the continued education of our coaches within SASC. The Coach Education and License Program will support coaches through the reimbursement of the course cost associated with higher level learning. Rules apply for paid or volunteer coaches.

SASC is committed to supporting its coaches through the following courses

CYSA F, E, D and GK Level 1

NSCAA Level 1 – 6, Special Topics, and DOC Diplomas

NSCAA GK Level 1 – 3, and Advanced National Goalkeeper Diplomas

NSCAA National, Advanced National, and Premier Diplomas

USSF National C, B, A, A renewal, and National Youth License

- 1) All F and E courses are reimbursed by SASC through CYSA for all coaches 100% on completion.
 - a. No pre-approval is needed.
- 2) CYSA D and GK Level 1 course, NSCAA Level 1 - 6 courses, GK 1-3 courses, Special Topics, is to be reimbursed by SASC for all coaches 100% on completion.
 - a. No pre-approval needed.
- 3) NSCAA Advanced National GK, DOC, National, Advanced National, Premier Diplomas.
 - a. 50% after completion. 50% after 12 months if still with SASC. All coaches.
 - b. All applications must be submitted to the DOC for approval prior to registration.
- 4) USSF C, B, A, A renewal, National Youth License.
 - a. 50% after completion. 50% after 12 months if still with SASC. All coaches.
 - b. All applications must be submitted to the DOC for approval prior to registration.
- 5) All Board Members will be exempt of 50% rule. They will receive 100% upon completion.
- 6) No other expenses will be paid. Travel, food, gas, hotel, etc.
- 7) All applications must go through DOC for approval. Priority will be given as follows.
 - a. Tenure with SASC. Longer tenure receives higher priority.
 - b. Applications received first.
 - c. Children playing in the club.
 - d. Amount of teams coaching with the club.
 - e. Other factors such as signing 1 year coaching contract will be considered.
- 8) Annual budget to be set at \$7500. Once budget is used, then applications will be moved to next year.
- 9) All applications must go through DOC for approval. Once approved. Higher level course applications only will be submitted to board for final approval at next available board meeting.
- 10) Once course is complete, application, a copy of the license or diploma, and receipt of payment, should be submitted to the Competitive Director for processing. competitive@sunnyvalesoccer.org
- 11) Coaches coaching outside SASC with other clubs will be ineligible for reimbursement.
- 12) Other courses such as first aid, safety, PCA, etc. not listed will be considered but must be approved by DOC prior.
